NOTICE INVITING TENDER.

On behalf of Chairman and Managing Director (CMD), digitally sealed tenders are invited by CMD, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. through the Telecom District Manager, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL), Wardha Telecom District from reliable and experienced contractors, who have completed trenching of OFC OR similar nature of civil (earth excavation) works in any Department or PSU of Govt. of India or State Govt. or Licensed Private Telecom Service Providers, for the work of excavation of trench up to depth given against each section for laying of MULTI PLB/HDPE/GI/RCC pipes and drawing of nylon ropes through them if required, reinstatement of the excavated trench, fixing & concreting of route indicators at approximately 200 Meters, making & refilling of AT pits, cable pulling and other associated works, including transportation as per construction specification given in the tender document as detailed below.

OR Can also be paid by cash payment to the Accounts Officer (Cash), at Cash Counter, O/o Telecom District Manager, Wardha 11:30hrs. to 13:00 hrs on all working days. 8) MSE/NSIC VENDORS	<p>MSE/NSIC bidders registered for similar items may claim exemption from payment of cost of tender form, EMD /Bid Security. The bidder shall furnish along with the bid a certificate/documentary proof in respect of registration clearly showing it’s validity as on date of opening of the bid. Moreover, they should also produce documentary evidence showing that the firm is MSE/NSIC registered for the items tendered for. In case the certificate viz. experience, registration etc. is issued in any other language other than Hindi/English/Marathi, the bidder shall attach an English</p>

	<p>translation of the same duly attested by the bidder & the translator to be true copy in addition to the relevant certificate.</p> <p>All documents should be digitally signed by the bidder/ vendor organization.</p>
	<p>“The TDM Wardha, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever and he is not bound to accept the lowest tender rate.</p> <p>During the entire evaluation process, if it is observed that the down loaded document and/or is tempered/altere d/modified in any way, the bid will be liable to be rejected and a case of fraud will be registered with Police. The tenders which are not submitted in above mentioned manner (1 to 10) will be rejected.</p>

Aggregate of all members should be of amount equal to 40% of the estimated tender cost. iii) Atleast one member should have turnover of amount of 25% of estimated tender cost & other members should have turnover of atleast 10% of the estimated cost. - (ii) Submission of:
 - a) Offline documents listed in Section IV-B clause 4.2 are mandatory non-compliance will result in outright rejection of the Bid.
 - b) Online documents, the bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms terms and specifications in the bid documents and clarifications/ amendments/ addenda if any. Failure to furnish all Information required as per the bid documents or submission of the bids not substantially responsive to the bid documents in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of bid.

The Bid, which is not accompanied by **the requisite bid security and cost of tender document**, shall be **summarily rejected**. Bid will not be accepted /received after expiry of schedule date and time.

The total estimated cost includes cost of trenching, pipe laying, cost of providing cement concrete, cost of materials (RCC Route Indicators, RCC Splice Chambers) as indicated in section XIV., laying of RCC/GI/DWC pipes, Cable pulling, Cable splicing, Cable termination, preparation of Pits, Fixing of Joint Chamber, Indicator, transportation of excess material and all other associated works. **Rate should be quoted percentage basis Above/Below/at Par in figures on standard scheduled rates.**
