Digitally sealed tenders are invited by Telecom District Manager, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL), Wardha for OFC (including BSNL's existing as well as NOFN incremental OFC) maintenance work for the eligible bidders for following Zones.

1) Area of contract.

The BSNL, at the time of award of work under the contract or during issue of work orders, reserves the right to decrease or increase the quantum of work OR withdraw tender at any stage as per requirement of BSNL. For this the decision of TDM Wardha will be final without any change in the rates or other terms and conditions. However the individual item of works may varied in any quantum within the overall limit of +/- 50 % of the contracted value in terms of rupees or in physical terms as BSNL decides. The estimated cost given in NIT may vary depending on the actual works.

The bidding process will be accepted only through e-Tendering platform.

1. There is separate tender for each Zone of SSA. Bidder can participate in tenders of multiple zones. 100% work will be awarded only to the L-1 bidder. If the offered rates of more than one bidder are same then work will be awarded to the bidder having more experience. Work to any agency will be awarded in only one zone of the SSA & maximum three zones in Maharashtra Circle.

4) Period of contract	One Year from the date of agreement (extendable by one year)
5) Available of e-Tender Documents	e-Tender document can be obtained by downloading it from the website www.eprocure.gov.in . The physical copy of the Tender document would not be available for sale. e-Tender documents will be available for downloading From 11/09/2018 to 03/10/2018.

6) MODE OF PAYMENT	<p>(i) The Tender fee in the event of downloading from website should be paid in the form of Crossed Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque issued by any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank in favour of “The AO(Cash),BSNL O/o TDM Wardha”</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Can also be paid by cash payment to the Accounts Officer (Cash), at Cash Counter Sanchar Bhavan, MIDC, Wardha, between 10.30hrs to 13.00 hrs on all working days. Original Cash Receipt shall be produced.</p> <p>(ii)The Crossed Demand Draft/ Bankers Cheque or Original Cash Receipt should be submitted offline in the envelop as mentioned in clause 4.2 of Section- IV B.</p> <p>(iii)The Tender fee is non-refundable & non-transferable.</p>
7) MSE VENDORS	<p>MSE/NSIC bidders registered for similar items may claim exemption from payment of cost of tender form, EMD /Bid Security. The bidder shall furnish along with the bid a certificate/documentary proof in respect of registration clearly showing it’s validity as on date of opening of the bid. Moreover, they should also produce documentary evidence showing that the firm is MSE/NSIC registered for the items tendered for. Failure to comply this provision shall result in summarily rejection of the bid.</p>
8) BID SECURITY / EMD : (Refer Clause 8 of Section IV A	<p>The bidder shall furnish the bid Security / EMD in a following way:-</p> <p>a) Demand Draft/ Banker’s cheque issued by any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank drawn in favor of “The Accounts Officer (Cash),BSNL O/o TDM Wardha OR Fixed Deposit Receipt”. OR</p> <p>b) Bank Guarantee from a Nationalised/scheduled bank drawn in favour of “The TDM, BSNL, Wardha” which should be valid for 180 days from the tender opening date.</p>
9) Terms and Conditions of the tender	<p>Tender bids received after due time & date will not be accepted by the online system.</p> <p>All documents submitted in the bid offer should be preferably in Hindi/English/Marathi. In case the certificate viz. experience, registration etc. is issued in any other language other than Hindi/English/Marathi, the bidder shall attach an English translation of the same duly attested by the bidder & the translator to be true copy in addition to the relevant certificate.</p> <p>All documents should be digitally signed by the bidder/ vendor BSNL.</p> <p>“The TDM, BSNL Wardha, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever and he is not bound to accept the lowest tender rate.</p> <p>The tenders which are not submitted in above mentioned manner will be liable to be rejected.</p> <p>During the entire evaluation process, if it is observed that the down loaded document is exactly not as per the original tender document and/or it is tempered/changed/ altered/modified in anyway, the bid will be liable to be rejected and a case of fraud will be registered with police.</p>
10) Eligibility Conditions	<p>Bidder must submit following documents with the tender form:</p>

Blue ink signed Original/Attested “Power of Attorney” in case a person other than the Bidder has signed the tender document. iii. Latest Income Tax Return along with photo copy of PAN Card. iv. Labour license for any of on going works, and if not available at the time of bid submission, enclose a declaration letter mentioning that labour license will be obtained on award of contract within stipulated period.
11) Experience certificate	<p>Executing works satisfactorily equivalent to 35% of the estimated cost of the Zone he is bidding for, during the last three financial year (including current financial year up to DNIT date).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Experience of OFC laying/OFC fault restoration work in DOT/BSNL/MTNL directly or through PSU’S authorized by DOT or PSU of Govt. of India or State Govt. 2) Experience of OFC laying/ OFC fault restoration work in any other telecom service provider also shall be acceptable. <p>Experience certificate should be issued by officer not below the rank of DGM of BSNL/MTNL/DOT or similar certificate issued by competent authority of Central Gov./State Gov./Gov. undertaking/Semi Gov. In case of private telecom service provider the certificate should be issued by CTO(Chief Technical Officer) /Project Manager/ Middle management officer level of the company.</p>
12) Turn over certificate	<p>The turn over certificate issued by the chartered accountant. Average annual financial turnover should be minimum 30% of the estimated bid value of the Zone he is bidding for, in the tender in last three financial years.</p>
13) Solvency certificate	<p>Solvency certificate from the banker of the Bidder for 40% of the estimated bid value of the Zone he is bidding for , in the tender . The solvency certificate shall not be older than One Year (OR Twelve months) from the date of issue of NIT.</p>
14) Registration of firm	<p>Copy of certificates of incorporation/copy of Registration of firm /copy of valid shop act license OR Copy of Partnership deed in case of partnership firm OR Copy of Memorandum and Article of Association in case of limited company.</p>
15) EPF Registration	<p>Valid EPF registration certificate.</p>
16) ESIC Registration	<p>Valid ESIC registration certificate , If not available at the time of bid submission enclose a declaration letter that it will be submitted at the time of agreement failing which EMD can be forfeited and party can be black listed from any tender in BSNL</p>
17) GST Registration	<p>Valid GST registration.</p>
18) Declaration regarding	<p>(1) Near relatives (declaration-I) (2) Black listing of firm (declaration-II) (3) Payment insulation undertaking (undertaking –III) (4) Under taking and declaration for understanding the terms and conditions of tender & specification of works (Undertaking –IV).</p>
19) MSE/NSIC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) MSE/NSIC certificate: Current and valid certificate. ii) List of all board of directors, if applicable. iii) Registration certificate / Acknowledgement of entrepreneurs memorandum issued by State Director of Industries or from secretariat for industrial assistance (SIA) , ministry of Industries , Government of India, if applicable.

	<p>iv) Clause by clause compliance / statement of deviation if any to the clauses of the tender document signed by the authorized signatory on letter head of the firm as per annexure.</p> <p>v) Undertaking that similar OFC maintenance work in three SSAs has not been allotted as on date of bid submission. In case award of OFC maintenance works in three SSAs is reached at any stage of bid finalization, the bidder must intimate the tendering authority immediately in this regard. In such cases bids will not be considered for finalization & any refund on account of EMD will be given.</p>
20) Contents of 2 nd envelope	Financial bid/ BoQ (to be submitted on line) original price schedule (BoQ) in xl /xls file format.

NOTE:-

- (i) Scanned copies of all original documents/notarized copy of all original documents are to be uploaded with Digital Signature wherever applicable.
- (ii) Submission of:
 - a) Offline documents listed in Section IV-B clause 4.2 are mandatory non-compliance will result in outright rejection of the Bid.
 - b) Online documents, the bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms terms and `specifications in the bid documents and clarifications/ amendments/ addenda if any. Failure to furnish all Information required as per the bid documents or submission of the bids not substantially responsive to the bid documents in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of bid.

The Bid, which is not accompanied by **the requisite bid security and cost of tender document**, shall be **summarily rejected**. Bid will not be accepted /received after expiry of schedule date and time. The Telecom District Manager, Wardha reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason what-so-ever.
